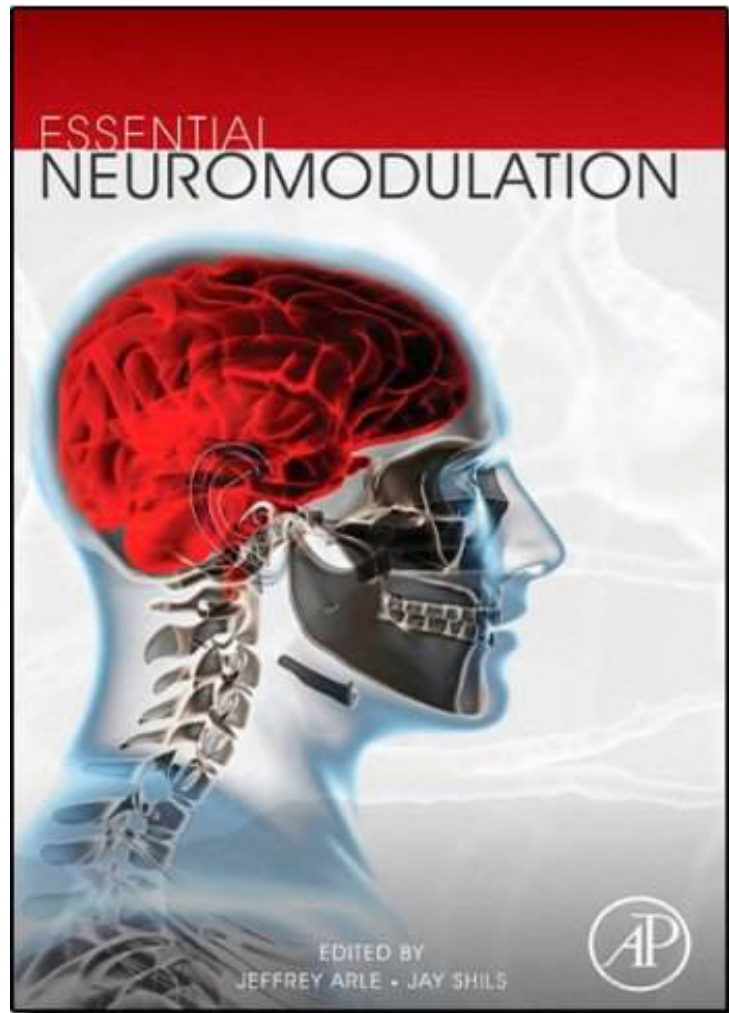


## Essential Neuromodulation
